Official Rules

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND REQUIRED TO ENTER OR WIN.

- 1. A "participating theatre" is an REG theatre that participates in the RCC. One transaction = one entry into the Sweepstakes for the authorized account holder of the RCC card, subject to the eligibility restrictions included in these Official Rules. Maximum of two entries per card per day. Potential winners may be required to show proof of being the authorized account holder. The "authorized account holder" is the natural person to whom the RCC card and account number were issued by REG.
